<u>Act It Out</u>	This is a drama-type class where we'll be acting out the stories from familiar books.		NO
<u>All About Weather</u>	We will learn all things weather – what causes different kinds of weather, clouds, and (hopefully) have a visit from a meteorologist!		NO
<u>American Girl – Class 1</u>	We will study the time periods that Kaya, Felicity, Samantha and Addy grew up in. One week will be a history lesson and the following week will include a craft and snack from that time period.		NO
<u>Animal Predators of the World</u>	God made an amazing world! Explore a different world biome each week, learning about predator/prey relationships and how they survive in their habitat.		NO
<u>Artistic Pursuits</u>	All new artists! Learn about an artist and then create a piece of artwork using different mediums that reflects a technique indicative of that artist.		NO
<u>Board Games</u>	This'll be a fun class where students get to learn new board/card games and socialize with other students.		NO
<u>Botany</u>	Intro to plants (their structure, propagation, classification, and more). We'll be loosely following along with Apologia's <u>Exploring Creation with Biology</u> textbook.		NO
<u>Builder's Challenge</u>	We'll have creative and imaginative building challenges with a variety of materials. We'll be utilizing STEM activities.		NO
